

Located in the centre of Bangladesh, Chandpur district lies under Chittagong division, and has an area of 1,704 square kilometres. It is bounded by Munshiganj and Comilla districts on the north, Noakhali, Lakshmipur and Barisal districts on the south, Comilla district on the east, and Shariatpur and Munshiganj districts on the west.

BRAC operates in Chandpur with quite a few components such as microfinance, education (BEP), health, nutrition and population (HNPP), community empowerment (CEP), human rights and legal aid services (HRLS), targeting the ultra poor (TUP), water, sanitation and hygiene (WASH) and the migration programme.
