We have a total of **9** staff, of whom **67%** are nationals of South Sudan. **33%** of the total staff are women.

KEY ACHIEVEMENTS

BRAC South Sudan reoriented its social development programmes after the so-called 2016 Juba clashes to consolidate programmes in the area up until March 2018. The organisation began implementing an emergency food security project in Juba and Torit in 2019, and is at the planning stage of an education project with local partner NGOs to be implemented in the second term.
