Purpose of Internship

The intern will gain valuable knowledge and insight on the **ASER (Annual Status of Education Report)** household-based survey that collects information on children's foundational literacy and numeracy status. S/He will be able to develop an assessment tool for the accelerated model school and implement it in the schools.

Intern's Responsibilities:

Core duties of the intern will include but shall not be limited to:

- Develop lessons for adolescent girls aiming to build functional numeracy, literacy and skills (health, nutrition, SRHR)
- Assist in developing operation guideline, learning materials and other document for the project
- Support to train staff/ facilitators regarding the project
- Visit fields for implementing the project and find the improvement area for further development
- Assist the facilitators to deliver lessons in the centers for better understanding

- Assist to write report on the prototypes with further improvements
- Maintain smooth, friendly and effective liaison with other BEP colleagues

Requirements

- b) Language Proficiency:** Fluent in spoken and writing for both Bangla and English Language
