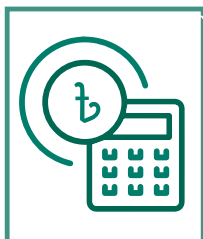

Outcome/ Objective

To support urban slum dweller communities (who are climate migrants) of Satkhira municipality with livelihood, housing and WASH through sustainable operation of infrastructures and essential climate resilient services



Key problems identified by the project

- ▶ Lack of community mobilization and leadership capacity among slum population
- ▶ Lack of climate resilient livelihood options
- ▶ Lack of training support from government and NGOs for developing sustainable livelihood and loan facilities
- ▶ Lack of climate resilient housing and WASH facilities
- ▶ Lack of knowledge on adaptive technology
- ▶ Lack of proper waste management facilities
- ▶ Lack of adequate health care services

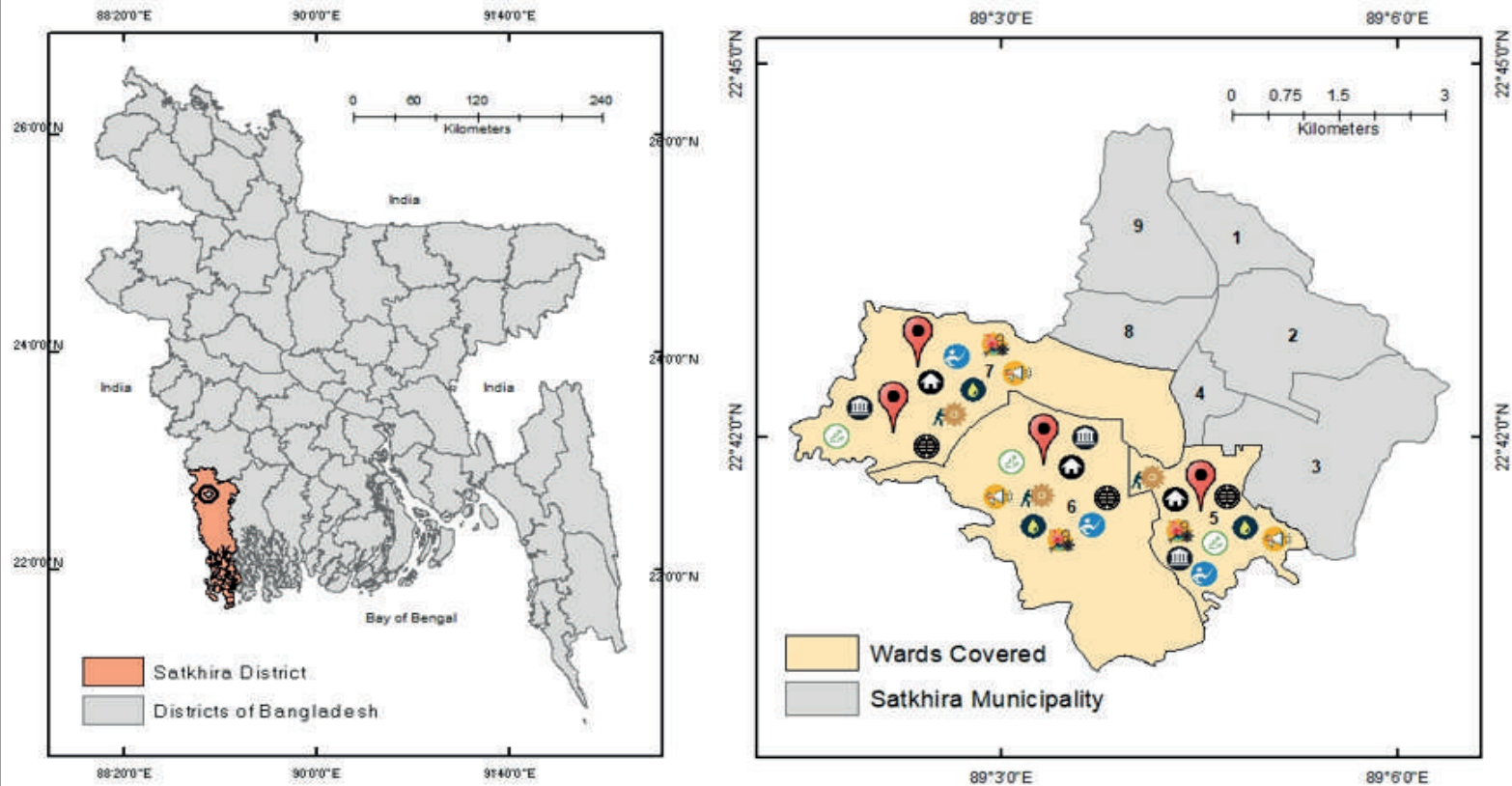


Highlights on proposed adaptation/ mitigation solutions

- ▶ Formation of women-led Self-Help Group (SHG)/ Community Based Organisation (CBO)
- ▶ Facilitate development of Risk Reduction Action Plan (RRAP) and Slum Risk Assessment (SRA)
- ▶ Provide skill development training and provide equipment for climate adaptive businesses
- ▶ Facilitate meetings with potential MSMEs for job placement
- ▶ Provide technical support to 75 slum women for homestead and roof top vegetables gardening
- ▶ Provide 80 climate adaptive insulation devices for slum housing facilities.
- ▶ Construct/repair 450 ft drainage and footpath, four climate resilient communal toilets, and six climate resilient communal deep tubewell with bathhouse
- ▶ Provide training to 150 climate migrants (women and men) on WASH practice during disasters

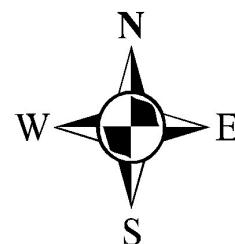
