

Located in south-central Bangladesh, Barguna district lies under Barishal division, and has an area of 1,831 square kilometres. The main rivers in the area are the Paira, Bishkhali, Khakdon and Baleshwar. It is bounded by Jhalokathi, Barishal, Pirojpur and Patuakhali districts on the north, Patuakhali district on the east and south, and Pirojpur and Bagerhat districts on the west.

BRAC operates in Barguna with a few programmes such as microfinance, health, nutrition and population (HNPP), community empowerment (CEP), human rights and legal aid services (HRLS), ultra poor graduation (UPG), and water, sanitation and hygiene (WASH).
